

Provenance

At 6,788 feet above sea level in the remote mountain town of Jesús María, Felipe Camarena masterfully crafts this bright, aromatic Blanco Clásico tequila from stressed hillside agave plants grown in tequila's highest-altitude agave region. Felipe's Destilería El Pandillo is arguably one of the most forwardthinking, innovative and sustainable distilleries in the business.

After select harvesting, the agave plants are slowly roasted in brick ovens and macerated intact with their fibers for a richer, fuller flavor. Following fermentation with rainwater, Felipe slowly distills this *selección* in small copper pot stills and aerates the spirit prior to bottling.
